










EU FOOTWEAR LABELLING: THE NEW DIRECTIVE

Pictograms or written indications concerning parts of footwear to be identified:

	Pictograms	Written Indication
Upper This is the outer face of the structural element which is attached to the outer sole.		Upper
Lining and Sock These are the lining of the upper and the insole, constituting the inside of the footwear article.		Lining and Sock
Outer Sole This is the bottom part of the footwear article which is subjected to abrasive wear and attached to the upper.		Outer Sole
Leather		Leather
Coated Leather Leather where the surface coating applied to the leather does not exceed one third of the total thickness of the product, but is in excess of 0.15mm.		Coated Leather
Textile Natural textile materials and synthetic or non-woven textile materials.		Textile
All other materials		Other Materials
