The division is at present conducting a survey which is intent on determining the important tests, analyses, substances and substrates that are deemed critical enough for national interest.

For more than ten years we have participated in the Regional Project for the development of Chemical Metrology through the Metrology Organisation of the Americas (SIM). With the knowledge gained we are attempting to set the groundwork for further developments in this critical area. At present we are conducting a survey of laboratories to ascertain which of the many areas of chemistry are most commonly practiced.

Chemical Metrology is a support to most of the industries most important to the economy and many of the services critical to the well being of the people of our society. The TTBS would like to join our colleagues in the Metrology Fraternity as well as the nations Chemists and practitioners in the field of chemistry in celebrating May 20th 2011 as World Metrology Day.
